

## FAQ's for Fun Fit and High Five

Q - What is the cost of training?

A - Training can be accessed in two ways:

<b>Learning Community training Federations &amp; Academy Trusts</b>	A suitable school hall within the Learning Community	One of our Senior Paediatric Occupational Therapists will attend to deliver the training session. <b>Vranch School based training</b>	Vranch House (Exeter)	Schools can send one or more members of staff to a session: <i>places must be booked in advance</i>	£70 per person (includes one copy of the Fun Fit/High Five book)

Q - How do I order a book?

A - Additional books for either Fun Fit or High Five can be purchased from Vranch House at a cost of £15.00 plus postage.

Q - How much space is needed to run a session?

A - For Fun Fit a large hall with enough space for a maximum of 20 people to try all activities. For High Five enough seating at a table for a maximum of 20 people.

Q - What equipment do we need to provide?

A - For Fun Fit - Facilities to run a Powerpoint presentation from a laptop. Seven mats, seven balls and seven beanbags.

For High Five facilities to run a Powerpoint presentation from a laptop. The Occupational Therapist will provide all the necessary equipment.

Q - When are sessions held:

A - Fun Fit is on a Wednesday usually between 1.00-.00pm. High Five is held on a Tuesday morning.
